| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Weapons – You may not bring any weapon to school or on the bus, even if it is a toy. <i>Note:</i> if you find a weapon – report it to a staff person or other adult as soon as possible. Telling the adult shows that you are being responsible and you are helping to keep everyone safe. You will not get in trouble for telling about a weapon you found. | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Attacking or assaulting another person;• Having alcohol or other drugs;• Making a threat to bring a bomb or other terroristic threats. |

You may be suspended or get another consequence if you do any of these behaviors:

| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make threats• Being physically aggressive• Fight with another student• Harass other people• Have tobacco in your possession• Have medicine in your possession• Open locked doors for other people to come in | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Steal, have stolen property in your possession, use school property without permission, or do vandalism• Trespass• Pull a false fire alarm• Bully another person or do hazing• Going out of the Emergency door without permission on the bus |
